Allied organizations/institutions whose purposes, goals or objectives are closely allied with or related to the function of the Council may be eligible for membership.

Each Veteran's organization and each Allied organization/institute shall designate in writing one representative and one alternate to attend Council meetings and represent its views, serve on Standing or Ad Hoc Committees, provide recommendations for consideration, and to vote in the affairs of the Council. Alternates will take the place of the primary representative when he/she is not present in a regular scheduled meeting of the Council and will be entitled to the rights and privileges of the primary representative.

Our Bylaws provide a mechanism for this to happen: Organizations interested in becoming a member of the Council shall submit a letter of application (see below) and the names of the Primary and alternative representative. For any questions call Kim Dees at 423-284-9432.
